Role Responsibilities

Leo Club Program Advisory Panelists will...

1. Establish relationships with Leos and Leo club advisors in their region and regularly collect feedback.
2. Coach and mentor Leos and Lions interested in further developing the Leo Club Program.
3. Serve as an advisor or speaker for Leo and Lion area forums and regional events.*
4. Maintain an active social media presence and promote Leo Club Program campaigns and initiatives.
5. Stay informed on the latest news about the Leo Club Program.
6. Serve as the official liaison between their area constituents and Lions Clubs International.
7. Provide feedback and share ideas with Lions International as it evaluates and plans Leo initiatives.
8. Advocate for the development and growth of Leos through the membership pathway to Lions.
9. Attend the Leo Advisory Panel training held virtually in June each year.
10. Attend monthly web meetings.
11. Help to plan and host constitutional area webinar(s).
12. Contribute to planning the April Panel Symposium, including regular committee meetings, hosting the webinar and creating resources.
