

District Leo Chairperson



Term

The district governor may choose to appoint a district Leo chairperson to serve in a one- or three-year term.

Position Overview

The district Leo chairperson shall contribute to the success of their districts through the promotion, development and continued support of Leos and Leo clubs.

Responsibilities

- Promote the reporting of Leo members, Leo club officers, Leo club advisors, Leo club and district service, as well as Leo training on the Lion Portal. Ensure Leo district officers are reported in the Lion Portal.
- Coordinate with the Leo/Leo-Lion cabinet liaison and/or Leo district president in promoting the Leo Club Program, including the development and organization of Leo clubs, the Leo-Lion Program and engagement opportunities for young people across the Lions district.
- Serve as the official liaison between the Lions district cabinet and the Leo district council, including reporting all resolutions of the Leo district conference to the Lions district cabinet and serving on the district Leo advisory committee, which supports, advises and publicizes Leo and Lions club activities.
- Oversee Leo district elections in collaboration with current Leo district officers and, should there be a vacancy, appoint a Leo district president or vice president per Chapter XXII of board policy.
- Serve as an advisory, non-voting member of the Leo district council.
- Work with Leo district officers to hold Leo club officer and Leo club advisor trainings and ensure that an annual learning and development calendar is established.
- Help to coordinate Leo grants.
- Promote Leo participation at Lions district events.
- Initiate and establish communications with Leo club advisors within the district, as well as collaborate with other district Leo chairpersons within the multiple district and the multiple district Leo chairperson.
- Facilitate Alpha to Omega transition, as well as Leo to Lion transition by supporting Leos joining existing or establishing new Leo or Lions clubs.
- Serve on the district organizing committee should the district governor authorize the formation of a Leo district.
- Work with the Leo/Leo-Lion cabinet liaison to organize Leo clubs and members in areas with no Leo districts.
- Review and approve Leo Club Program Advisory Panel applicants from the Leo district. Collaborate with and promote the Leo Club Program Advisory Panel to strengthen the Leo Club Program.
