





GRANT AWARDS BY CAUSE AREA

FY2021-2022 (US\$)









Identify a project that addresses an unmet humanitarian need for an underserved population.

Remember! Lion involvement essential for grant approval; leads to more successful projects





Discuss your project idea with others who can provide guidance and serve as resources.

Remember! LCIF staff available to guide project idea through submission process





Determine which LCIF grant could fund your project.

Tip! DCG program supports broad range of projects and activities





Partner with LCIF to ensure a successful application.

Don't forget! Before submitting new application, check status of current applications and open grants





Before applying, learn which LCIF grant programs have a matching funds requirement.

Special tip! Lions' strong financial commitment can make project even more successful





Answer all application questions thoroughly and provide supporting documentation, including a detailed budget.

Remember! Detailed, thorough application ensures smoother review process





Include required application approvals and attachments.

Did you know? To be considered, application must be locally approved and/or endorsed





Understand how to submit an application.

Tip! Emailing electronic copy of application begins review process sooner





Don't miss your chance!
Be sure to meet grant
application deadlines.

Don't forget! Submitting application well before deadline provides time to make needed changes





Be patient after submitting your grant application.

Be optimistic! Many applications approved fully; prepare for positive outcome





COMMON GRANT MISTAKES

- Incomplete application
- Vague application
- Budget includes ineligible expenses
- No quotes or estimates provided
- Lacking required endorsements

- Does not include appropriate minutes certifying the application
- Budget does not meet local matching fund requirement (where applicable)
- Single club projects (except DCG projects)
- Too many open grants or failure to submit final reports

HUNGER GRANT EXAMPLES

DISTRICT A-2

- ➤ US\$16,275 || Canada
- ➤ Furnish a feeding center for disadvantaged people in Ontario

District 318-C

- ➤ US\$84,225 || India
- ➤ Upgrade kitchen and dining facilities in rural childcare centers

District 11-C1

- ➤ US\$45,000 || USA
- Expand industrial freezer in food bank





CHILDHOOD CANCER GRANT EXAMPLES

DISTRICT 318 E

- ➤ US\$32,025 || India
- Construct a children's library, children's conference hall, and mini theater at a government-run cancer center

District 27-E2

- ➤ US\$10,485 || USA
- Construct a child-friendly waiting room at a clinic that provides cancer treatments to children

District 300-A3

- ➤ US\$150,000 || China Taiwan
- Construct a child-friendly area at a cancer center, including a playground, reading space, and multimedia space






MATCHING GRANT EXAMPLES

DISTRICT 108-IB1

- ➤ US\$100,000 || Italy
- Renovated a nature trail for the disabled creating a pedestrian trail, adding braille signs, tactile touch panels, wheelchair accommodated benches and tables, and a sensory garden

District O-5

- ➤ US\$100,000 | Argentina
- Constructed a guide dog school. School initially used Lions club clubhouse and a local farm. LCIF Matching grant helped create a permanent space.
