**PARADE PARTICIPATION** – The parade route runs through beautiful Downtown Montréal, along Sainte-Catherine Street. The parade route is less than one mile (approximately 1 kilometer) in length.

**ASSEMBLY AREA** – Marchers will assemble on Sainte-Catherine Street and some on the side streets of Mackay, Bishop and Crescent based on transfer arrangements for each delegation. Parade management and marshals in the assembly area will direct participants to their designated color-coded assembly areas.

**CONVENTION SHUTTLE** – Buses will drop off on Guy Street at the intersection of Sainte-Catherine Street and Guy Street.

**BAND BUSES** – Buses will drop off on Guy Street at the intersection of Sainte-Catherine Street and Guy Street unless advised otherwise by the Parade Marshals.

**PRIVATE CHARTER BUSES** – All private buses must register with LCI to receive the official LCI Parade of Nations vehicle label for access into the drop-offs at event venue. Delegations with private-chartered buses will be required to inform LCI on the final count of buses by **May 13, 2022**.

**FLOATS** – Delegations with float arrangements are to inform LCI by **May 13, 2022**. All parade floats will assemble on Sainte-Catherine Street and some on the side streets of Mackay, Bishop, and Crescent (based on transfer arrangements for each delegation) at 7:00 am on June 25, 2022 — approximately 2 hours prior to step off. Location may be subject to changes and delegations will be notified in advance.

**LINE OF MARCH** – The parade will begin at the intersection of Sainte-Catherine Street and Rue de la Montagne. The parade route is less than one mile (approximately 1.4 kilometer) in length.

**JUDGES/VIP REVIEWING AREAS** – The judging area is located near Phillips Square on Sainte-Catherine Street.

**IMPORTANT: NO STOPPING OR DELAY OF THE FORWARD MOTION OF PARADE UNITS IS PERMITTED** for special maneuvers or presentation in the judging areas. Contest units in violation will be penalized judging points.

**PARADE VIEWING** – Parade viewing in the assembly area is not permitted. The parade route offers excellent viewing from the following viewing all along Sainte-Catherine Street between Rue de la Montagne and Rue de Bleury.

**DISPERSAL AREA** – Marchers will be directed by parade marshals and staff upon reaching the dispersal area (Rue de Bleury Route).

**PICK UP POINT FOR CONVENTION SHUTTLE BUSES** – Marchers will disperse at Rue de Bleury and proceed to the Palais des congrès de Montréal where buses will be staged.

**DISPERSAL AREA FOR BANDS** – Bands will disperse on Rue Saint-Alexandre, and they will be directed to the exit roads by the parade marshals and staff.

**DISPERSAL AREA FOR FLOATS** – Floats will disperse on Rue Saint-Alexandre, and they will be directed to the exit roads by the parade marshals and staff.

**FIRST AID** – Paramedics will be stationed along the parade route. If medical assistance is required, please notify the nearest police officer or parade official for help. We suggest you assign a qualified person within your unit to “spot” any problems with participants.
