



#### **Donor Services Team Overview**

#### Team Responsibilities

- Identify, record, and acknowledge all contributions to LCIF
- Monthly reconciliation of donation totals
- Administration of all LCIF recognitions, including fulfillment and vendor management
- Comprehensive data collection, archiving, and storage of donation and recognition information
- Develop new reports and maintain LCIF data
- Inquiry handling from members or general public regarding donations, recognitions, reports, or general information about LCIF

#### **Donor Services Team Overview**

#### **Donation Payment Methods**

- <u>Credit Card</u>: One-time and recurring donations can be made on our website by selecting the "Donate" link
- Wire Transfer: Wire transfers can be sent directly to LCIF's bank account
- **USD Check:** Checks in USD can be sent directly to the Foundation's lockbox
- Local Bank Deposit: In countries where LCI has a bank account, donations can be deposited into the LCI account
- <u>India</u>: Donations can be sent to *Lions Clubs International Foundation India*, a company registered under Section 8 of the Companies Act, 2013. Donations made towards Lions Clubs International Foundation India are eligible for deduction under section 80 G
- <u>Canada</u>: Donations can be sent to the *Lions of Canada Fund for LCIF*. Donations made towards this fund are eligible for tax deduction.
- <u>Australia</u>: Donations can be sent to the *Lions Australia Fund for LCIF*. Donations made towards this fund are eligible for tax deduction.






