Faculty Development Institute (FDI)

Lions Certified Instructor Program (LCIP)

What is the purpose of this training?	To develop and expand the number of skilled Lions faculty available for use in training at the club, district, and multiple district levels.	To deliver consistent effective training at all levels within Lions by increasing the number of qualified instructors , while also providing a framework for broadening and deepening the knowledge and experience of the instructors.
What can I expect to gain from this training?	The curriculum is designed to enhance training delivery skills and training techniques that will increase the quality of training and overall effectiveness of Lions leadership development programs.	The curriculum is designed to confirm understanding of key training skills and to gain additional training strategies and techniques from fellow participants. Also, increased confidence in one's training skill through peer and faculty feedback.
Who should apply to attend?	Inexperienced and experienced trainers who would like to improve their training delivery skills.	FDI graduates and non-FDI graduates with extensive training experience.
How can I become an FDI graduate/LCIP Certified?	Attend the FDI and complete the post-FDI assignment for FDI graduation.	Attend an LCIP training and meet certification requirement.

* Effective July 2020, LCIP certification is a requirement to serve as faculty at Lions Clubs International-directed institutes and FVDG/DGE Seminar.

** Effective July 1, 2020, all LCIP certifications received within a Lions fiscal year will be valid for three years but not to exceed four years. Year one will be considered the fiscal year which the certification was awarded within. The recertification period will be from July 1 thru June 30 of the 4th year of certification.
