



1. What are the goals for the 2021-22 FY?

For the 2021-22 District Goals, the Executive Officers ask that you and your district team develop specific target numbers and action plans for the following association goals:

- By the end of the 2021-2022 fiscal year, our district will increase the percentage of clubs reporting service (meet or exceed last year's service reporting numbers).
- By the end of the 2021-2022 fiscal year, our district will achieve a positive membership growth (meet or exceed last year's membership numbers).
- By the end of the first quarter of the 2021-2022 fiscal year, our district will hold training for club officers and zone chairpersons. The district GLT coordinator will report each training using the local training reporting tool in Learn.
- By the end of the 2021-2022 fiscal year, our district will support Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) in its endeavor to achieve Campaign 100's target goal of US\$300 million.

2. Who should provide support in the development of the 2021-22 District Goals?

The 1VDG/DGE should work with their 2VDG, District GMT, GST, GLT and LCIF Coordinators to develop their district goals and action plans. Before submitting, review your goals and action plans with your multiple district and GAT area leadership to provide any additional support.

3. Where can I find metrics to support my district in the development of our goals and action plans?

The District Strategic Plan Workbook directs district teams to platforms such as Insights, LCI Real Time Reports and the Membership Reports Toolbox, where users can find service, membership, leadership and LCIF data to support in the development of the 2021-22 District Goals.

4. When can I submit my district goals?

The link to the 2021-22 District Goals submission platform opens on April 9, 2021. Once available, work with your district team to review and develop all action items before submitting your completed 2021-2022 District Goals.

5. Where do I go to submit my district goals?

The 2021-22 District Goals webpage has the link to submit your goals.

6. What browser should I use to submit my District Goals?

Chrome or Firefox; do not use Internet Explorer, as it is not compatible with the District Goals platform.

7. Our district holds training for club officers and/or zone chairpersons before the start of the fiscal year, what is the process for completing my leadership development goal?

In the development of the district-specific goal, DGEs will want to indicate when the 2021-22 incoming officer training will be held prior to July 1, 2021 and indicate a deadline for when the GLTs will report the training in Learn. They may also choose to indicate that the training for the 2022-23 incoming officers (of which they will be responsible for in their DG term) will be provided in June 2022.

8. I lost the confirmation email with the link to view/edit my submitted goals. How can I go back in to modify my goals?

If you lost your confirmation email, you will need to contact the Global Action Team department at GAT@lionsclubs.org or call +1.630.203.3815, and a new email can be resent.

9. How can I view/print my goals?

Beginning in May, you will be able to view/print submitted goals on the 2021-22 District Goals webpage. If you need to view goals sooner, you can use the link in the confirmation email to access the goals directly from the site.

****Please note: your goals will show on the view/print screen 24 hours after submission****

10. When do I need to have my district goals submitted?

Goals need to be submitted by June 30, 2021.

11. When is the last day to edit my district goals once they have been submitted?

The last day to make changes to your submitted goals and action plans is December 31, 2021.

12. What is the role of the multiple district (MD) team?

In order to promote regionalization, multiple districts have the opportunity to create a S.M.A.R.T (specific, measurable, actionable, realistic and time-bound) goal for the 2021-22 FY that reflects the needs of their area. Connect with your MD to verify if a S.M.A.R.T goal will be created.
