#### Arrivals

The airport shuttle bus will drop you off at the Q Center Welcome Center. There you may pick up your room keys from the Q Center front desk. Then head to the Lions Clubs International registration desk to pick up your name badge, program guide, group schedule and photo form. Please wear your name badge at all times. You are free to get settled in your guest room until Monday 20:00 for the Seminar Welcome in your classroom.



#### Meals

The FVDG/DGE Seminar package at the Q Center includes three complimentary buffet-style meals per day beginning with dinner on the arrival day and ending with lunch on the departure day.
