



## Lions Clubs International Parade of Nations Frequently Asked Questions

1. How do I register for the Parade of Nations?  
Answer: The Parade Rules and Regulations can be found at: <http://lcicon.lionsclubs.org/experience/parade-of-nations>
2. Do I register for the parade as an individual?  
Answer: No. Lions should register as a Multiple District or Single District. The Council Chairperson for the Multiple District or the District Governor of a Single District registers the entire delegation for the parade and coordinates the parade wear, band and/or float for the parade. Please contact your Council Chairperson or District Governor for more information about participating in the parade with your delegation.
3. Will there be toilets along the parade route?  
Answer: Yes, portable toilets are placed at the Assembly Area and Dispersal Area. There are public toilets located at the Gardens by the Bay and Marina Barrage.
4. We are not registered for the convention. Can we march with our delegation in the parade?  
Answer: In order to participate in the Parade of Nations, each individual should be registered for the convention and display their convention name badge during the parade.
5. What are the delegations' responsibilities at the parade?  
Answer: The parade will take place at a park. The delegation's authorized representative will ensure that all trash is properly disposed of in receptacles while in the assembly and dispersal areas. Additionally, the delegation's authorized representative is responsible for maintaining order and responding to any order by parade officials or police relating to their delegation. Failure to comply will eliminate participation of the unit or delegation.
6. Will the parade be cancelled if it rains?  
Answer: The parade will take place 'rain or shine'. Only under extreme weather conditions will the parade be cancelled. The local Emergency Services agency will make the call on the parade if extreme conditions are anticipated. Lions will be notified via their delegation lead, social media, and in the official LCI hotels.
7. Our delegation wishes to hire a band for the parade, who do we contact?  
Answer: The Host Committee Parade Chair is the liaison between the bands and delegations. Please contact the Parade Chairs.

Answer: Shuttles at the dispersal will transport parade attendees to their hotels via Sands Expo and Convention Centre (SANDS). Public transportation is also available.
