- 1968** – LCIF founded
- 1972** – First grant awarded
- 1984** – Partnership with Quest (now known as Lions Quest) begins
- 1990** – SightFirst program begins and raises US\$145 million through Campaign SightFirst
- 1999** – Partnership with The Carter Center begins to combat river blindness and trachoma
- 2001** – LCIF partners with Special Olympics through the Opening Eyes program
- 2008** – Campaign SightFirst II raises more than US\$205 million
- 2012** – One Shot, One Life: Lions Measles Initiative raises US\$10 million
- 2018** – LCIF awards US\$1 billion in grants
- 2021** – Lions Quest reaches 110 countries
- 2022** – Campaign 100 raises US\$325 million for humanitarian service
- 2024** – Sight For Kids, a 20+ year partnership between LCIF and Johnson & Johnson to improve eye health, screens over 50 million school children
