Hunger is an everyday presence for some, stressful both physically and mentally. When trying to gain financial stability, hunger can be detrimental.

In Argenteuil County, Quebec, many families

experience hunger. Offering a bit of relief, d'Entraide d'Argenteuil, the local community centre, provides food

and empowering social services. "The centre is dedicated to giving the best service," said one grateful patron. "And they always have a smile to welcome us with!"

Thanks to LCIF, the centre is able to provide food for nearly 1,500 people.

d'Entraide d'Argenteuil is a vital part of the

neighbourhood, so when its refrigerated truck broke down, locals who rely on the centre were in for an abrupt change. With the truck beyond repair, seriously limiting the centre's ability to provide fresh food, local Lions knew they needed to act.

With a nearly US\$27,000 Matching grant from Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF), Lions purchased d'Entraide d'Argenteuil a new truck, modifying it with a refrigeration system. Thanks to LCIF and Lions, the centre is able to once again provide a bounty of fresh food to its nearly 1,500 weekly patrons.
