

# Multiple District Leo Chairperson

## Term

The Council of Governors may choose to appoint a multiple district Leo chairperson to serve in a one- or three-year term.

## Position Overview

Multiple district Leo chairpersons shall contribute to the success of their multiple districts through the promotion, development and continued support of Leos and Leo clubs.

## Responsibilities

- Promote the reporting of Leo members, Leo club officers, Leo club advisors, district Leo chairpersons, Leo club, district and multiple service, as well as Leo training on the Lion Portal. Ensure Leo multiple district officers are reported in the Lion Portal.
- Coordinate with the Leo/Leo-Lion council liaison and/or Leo multiple district president in promoting the Leo Club Program, including the development and organization of Leo clubs, the Leo-Lion Program and engagement opportunities for young people across the Lions multiple district.
- Serve as the official liaison between the council of governors and the Leo multiple district council, including reporting all resolutions of the Leo multiple district conference to the Lions multiple district council and serving on the multiple district Leo advisory committee, which supports, advises and publicizes Leo and Lions club activities.
- Oversee Leo multiple district elections in collaboration with current Leo multiple district officers and, should there be a vacancy, appoint a Leo multiple district president or vice president per Chapter XXII of board policy.
- Serve as an advisory, non-voting member of the Leo multiple district council.
- Work with Leo multiple district officers to hold Leo district officer trainings and establish an annual learning and development calendar.
- Help to coordinate Leo grants.
- Promote Leo participation at Lions multiple district events.
- Work with district Leo chairpersons across the multiple district, meeting at least quarterly, to support their efforts in facilitating Leo-to-Lion transition, reporting officers and providing training opportunities for Leos.
- Facilitate Alpha to Omega transition, as well as Leo to Lion transition by supporting Leos joining existing or establishing new Leo and Lions clubs.
- Serve on the multiple district organizing committee should the council of governors authorize the formation of a Leo multiple district.
- Work with the Leo/Leo-Lion council liaison to organize Leo clubs and members in areas with no Leo multiple districts.
- Review and approve Leo Club Program Advisory Panel applicants from the Leo multiple district. Collaborate with and promote the Leo Club Program Advisory Panel to strengthen the Leo Club Program
