

**ANDREJA STOJKOVSKI**  
**INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR**

Andreja Stojkovski from Skopje, North Macedonia, was elected to serve a two-year term as an international director of Lions Clubs International at the association's 108th international convention in Hong Kong, China, July 3 through July 7, 2026.

Director Stojkovski has 26 years of experience working in public policy. He is currently an executive director at the PRESPA Institute, where he leads work in foreign and security policy, European affairs and democratic governance.

He began his service in 1999 as the first Leo in his country, organizing and serving as charter president of the first Leo Club. He became a Lion in 2004, and since 2015 has served as a member of the Skopje Matka Lions Club.

Director Stojkovski has served in a range of leadership roles within the association at club and district level, including as district governor, cabinet secretary and Global Leadership Team district coordinator. Internationally, he has contributed as GAT Specialist and as Group Leader, Specialist and Associate at District Governor-Elect Seminars, as well as faculty at leadership institutes across Europe. He has organized seven Lions clubs and sponsored 58 members.

In recognition of his service to the association, Director Stojkovski has received numerous awards including the Club Excellence Award, Grand Master Key Award and District Governor Excellence Award, among others.

He is also the recipient of multiple International President's Awards, International President's Leadership Awards and International President's Certificates of Appreciation. Additionally, Director Stojkovski is a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow.

In addition to his Lion activities, Director Stojkovski served as Special Advisor to the Prime Minister of North Macedonia and Deputy Chief Negotiator for EU Accession, and was appointed Special Representative of the OSCE Chairperson-in-Office for Civil Society, engaging in policy dialogue and across 57 participating states. He was also a member of the Civil Society Council of the Government of North Macedonia, the Permanent Strategic Council of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the MK@NATO Project Board, and is currently a member of the OSCE Expert Network.

Director Stojkovski and his wife, Zhivka, also a Lion, have one child.
