Club Officer Training:

The second vice district governor training is a blended learning program designed to meet the development and training needs of the second vice district governor.

First Vice District Governors/District Governors-Elect (FVDGs/DGEs) Training Program:

The First Vice District Governors/District Governors-Elect (FVDGs/DGEs) Training Program is an intensive year-long program designed to equip FVDGs/DGEs with the knowledge, vision, and skills necessary to strengthen and build Lions Clubs International.

Advanced Lions Leadership Institute (ALLI):

The ALLI focuses on building the skills of Lions leaders to better prepare them for leadership responsibilities at the zone, region and district levels.

Emerging Lions Leadership Institute (ELLI):

The ELLI is designed to build the skills of Lions leaders to prepare them to assume leadership responsibilities at the club level.

Regional Lions Leadership Institute (RLLI):

The RLLI program is designed to build the skills of Lions leaders to prepare them to assume leadership responsibilities at the district level.

Local Institute Program:
