

Cleaning Checklist: Reach-In Refrigerators How to Keep Your Equipment in Top Shape

1. Clean Interior



Wipe interior of machine with baking soda and water mix (1 TBSP baking soda to 1 pint water). All interior fittings are removable without tools to facilitate cleaning.

2. Clean Exterior



Wipe exterior of the machine with warm water, mild soap and a soft cloth. Wipe in the direction of the metal grain. For stubborn spills, use baking soda mix in previous step. Do not use strong detergents and cleansers containing chlorine.

3. Inspect Door Gasket



Open cabinet doors to inspect gasket. Pull gasket with hand and inspect the gasket for tear, dirt, mold or wear. Wipe with cloth and replace as needed.

4. Clean Condenser Coil



Remove the two bottom screws securing the panel and pivot panel upwards for full access to the condenser. Vacuum or brush any dirt, lint or dust from the condenser coil. If significant dirt is clogging the condenser, use compressed air to clear. Return the panel and screws.
