

Virtual FVDG/DGE Seminar Tips

Invest Intentionally

- Secure appropriate computer equipment, such as a personal computer or tablet, before the seminar begins.
- Use equipment and training platform features, such as audio and video, to participate fully in all aspects of the training.
- Review the virtual platform user guides and participant manual before the live virtual sessions begin and keep them within easy reach.
- Plan to continue using this equipment to your advantage in performing your duties as district governor.

Communicate Competently

- Check emails daily for Lions messages and reply or respond as requested.
- Ask your group leader questions regarding any issue related to your training or preparation for service as district governor.
- Participate in email and social media discussion forums with your fellow DGEs to exchange ideas and best practices during and after the seminar.

Participate Passionately

- Delve into the subjects and take your time with the assigned materials.
- Complete all pre-assignments as scheduled so you're prepared for the live virtual sessions.
- Conclude session curriculum by completing all post-assignments as directed to reinforce your learning.



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Apply Appropriately

- Write down how you plan to apply the leadership skills you learn (what, with whom, when, where, why and how).
- Discuss, with other leaders in your district, how you can implement newly acquired skills and ideas during the leadership transition.
- Integrate small, but concrete, aspects of your new skills right away, and work every day toward becoming the Lion leader you want to be.
