[Transportation to MiCo for Service Project Check-In](#)

Shuttles will be available for service project participants at designated LCI shuttle stops at 07:00 on Friday, July 5. Please allow a 15-minute grace period as shuttle arrival times will vary depending on your stop. Shuttles will load from designated shuttle loading areas, which are different at each hotel. **Please check hotel lobby transportation signs**, and allow ample time for walking to the shuttle loading area – your shuttle stop may be located at a different hotel. Shuttles will not return for any late passengers. LCI will not reimburse any personal ground transportation expenses for service projects.

If you are not staying near one of the LCI shuttle stops, it is your responsibility to get to one.

Public transportation to the MiCo: You can also reach the MiCo by the Metro (Portello underground station of the purple line will bring you right to the MiCo).

- **Description of Duties:** Volunteers will rotate through various group activities with children; a limited number of volunteers will serve as assistants to physician clowns.
- **Dress Code:** Volunteers must wear pants, closed-toe shoes and the service project t-shirt provided upon check-in at the MiCo.
- **Weather:** Project will happen rain or shine.
- **Activity Level:** Light; volunteers will be standing and walking.
- **Water:** Drinking water will be provided.
- **Restrooms:** Restrooms are available at the MiCo during check-in and at La Nostra Famiglia Hospital. Shuttles do NOT have restrooms.
- **Personal Belongings:** We recommend leaving all valuables at your hotel.
