

**GREGORY “GREG” K. CRAPO
INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR**

Gregory “Greg” K. Crapo, of Biloxi, Mississippi, USA, was elected to serve a two-year term as an international director of Lions Clubs International at the association’s 108th international convention in Hong Kong, China, July 2 through July 7, 2026.

Director Crapo has a bachelor’s degree from the University of South Alabama and a Master of Business Administration from the University of Southern Mississippi. He is the executive director of de l’Epee Deaf Center as well as the Secretary of Housing for the Catholic Diocese of Biloxi.

A member of the Biloxi Lions Club since 1981, a club to which his late father also belonged, Director Crapo has held several offices within the association including club president, district governor, zone chairman, district Leo club chairman, district treasurer, district convention chairman and Leadership Development Chair. He has also served as MD 30 treasurer and president of the Mississippi Lions Sight Foundation. Additionally, he has held several MD committee and convention roles. He was a 2026 USA/Canada Lions Leadership Host Forum Committee member and is a Lions University master’s degree recipient.

In addition to his many Lions roles, Director Crapo has been involved in several other civic activities. He is the founder of Biloxi Lions, Inc, which awards educational scholarships and supports other non-profits in sight preservation, founded the Sea & Sun Camp for the visually impaired, and created The Tabitha Project, a ministry devoted to people with special needs.

Director Crapo has received numerous awards from Lions including several International Leadership Awards, several International Presidents Awards and he was also named a 100% district governor. He was inducted into the Mississippi Lions Hall of Fame in 2008 and is a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow.
